### This Week in OSHC...

After a discussion on some 'big projects' the children have shown enthusiasm for the options to 'build' something. So for the first semester, all of the children will have the opportunity to join in as we work towards a major project. There have been a few ideas put forward that will be discussed further in time. We will start by learning some of the basics in handling tools safely and to help with this, I have contacted Bunnings to see if they are able to help.

As children are also interested in taking things apart, we will be resourcing the materials needed for our project by recycling different items.

At OSHC we offer a range of movement, active play and sport activities. This week the children have spent time on the playground enjoying free play (climbing, balancing and strength building activities) and organised play in the form of obstacle courses and tag. Each night I pick an activity where I ask the children for some feedback, this resulted in finding an obstacle course that was fairer for all children to participate in. When inside the children engage in dancing as an activity, which utilises stretching and coordination and follows children's interest beautifully. *"Children need lots of movement and physical activity every day. That's because movement is vital for health and wellbeing. Moving strengthens muscles and bones and improves coordination." (raisingchildren.net.au).*
